- Develop a progressive waste management strategy to reduce the volumes of wastes sent to landfill through waste minimisation, re-use, recycling and recovery
- Through appropriate waste control systems prevent the deliberate release into water, air, or land any substance in solid, liquid or gaseous form that shall cause pollution
- Evaluate the use of alternative fuel cars to ascertain their potential benefit to the fleet
- Ensure vehicles are properly maintained - poorly maintained vehicles have higher fuel consumption and toxic emission levels
- Develop policies to manage the added risks, costs and environmental impacts of the 'grey' fleet
- We will work in partnership with our clients and supply chain partners to assist them in achieving sustainable working environments and supporting their sustainability innovations
- Communicate our policy and plans to our stakeholders and review our performance regularly
